

themes

- **Dependance on God:** Everything we have comes from God, and apart from Him, we are nothing.
- Surrender and Humility: We acknowledge God's sovereignty and fall at His feet in heartfelt surrender.
- Praise: We offer God praise and thanksgiving for His deep love for us.

discuss

- What theme in this song challenges you the most?
- What line or word from the song resonates with you? Why?
- What things in your life do you need to surrender to God?
- What is your understanding of 'I am nothing without You?'

activity

Using the tree image (see next page), write or draw around the tree the things in your life that you're grateful to God for. Examples include:

- Family, friends and pets
- Sunrises/sunsets and nature
- Food, water and shelter
- Your gifts and talents
- Your experiences

Once you've completed this activity, write a prayer to God thanking Him for all the things you wrote/drew on the tree. Students can also colour in the tree once finished.

exploring the lyrics

'I am nothing without You'

This line powerfully conveys our dependance on God, and without Him, we are empty.

John 15:5: 'I am the vine, you are the branches.

Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing'

'For the rest of my life, I lay it all in Your hands'

We surrender all we have to God, as we don't know what's coming next. We trust that He will guide us according to His purpose.

James 4:14: 'Yet you do not even know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes.'

'I'll never understand how much You love me'

We will never know the breath of God's love for us, but we see a fraction of it revealed in Jesus' sacrifice on the cross.

'How can I thank You for all that You've done, for all that You're doing'

We must have deep gratitude as we don't know all that God has done for us, and is currently doing for us.

'You're my everything'

We are nothing without Him, but He is everything. With God, everything falls into place and He works everything out for our good.

Colossians 1:17: "He is before all things, and in him all things hold together".
